# Roulette

Roulette has been played for over 300 years – and the rules are still the same.

### Originally French

The first Roulette table was to be found in Paris, so it's no wonder that when it was first played the main terms were in French: from "Faites vos jeux!" to "Rien ne va plus!".

The exception to the rule: American Roulette. It's not only the name that is different - so are the table and rules, which makes for a quicker game.

### Brand new Eurolette

Eurolette, the new bar-shaped Roulette table, combines the best of both worlds. It is played on a French table, but at the American speed. Eurolette is currently only available in Baden-Württemberg.

## French Roulette

### The aim of the game

The player who has bet on the number, or the group of numbers, on the wheel where the ball lands has won.

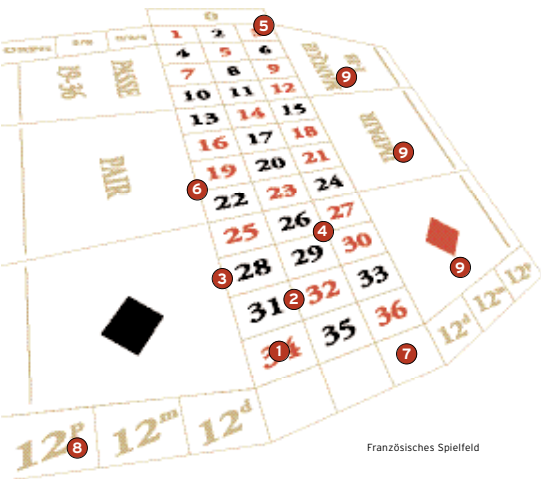
### The table

Roulette is played at a table. It contains the Roulette wheel and the actual playing field, or tableau. There are 37 small slots in the wheel, randomly numbered from 0 to 36. They alternate between red and black; only the zero is green. The number fields on the tableau are numbered sequentially. All the other chance fields are positioned along the edge.

### The chips

A bet is made by placing a chip on a particular field. Each chip represents a specific amount of money, indicated by the color, shape and number on the chip. They are available from the cashier and at the table. The croupiers manage the game and will help you with your bets.

## Playing the game

"Place your bets, please!" - the croupier instructs the players at the table to place their bets. Put your chips wherever you like.

The croupier throws the ball into the wheel and closes the betting with the words, "No more bets, please!".

As soon as the ball has come to a halt in one of the slots, the croupier calls out the number and indicates it on the tableau. For instance, "28, black, pair, passe". The bets on these fields win, and the winnings are immediately paid out. Losing bets go to the bank.

There are different ways of winning at Roulette. The amount is determined by the probability of the ball landing on a particular number. Betting on a round number (plein) - 28 in our example - offers the maximum opportunity for winning; it would bring you 35 times the amount you bet.

It's a tradition of Roulette that a win on a round number is celebrated by tipping the staff one chip.

## Betting Possibilities and Payoffs on the Table

An additional rule is applicable to the simple bets: If the zero wins, half of the amount bet is lost and the bets are blocked. If the zero wins again, the blocked bets are double-blocked. All double-blocked bets are lost if the zero comes up again.

## Bets from the wheel

"Announces" are bets that result from the arrangement of the numbers in the wheel. They can also be played on the corresponding fields on the table.

### Large series 0/2/3

Bet on a combination of 17 neighboring numbers (neighbors).

### Small series 5/8

Bet on a combination of 12 adjoining numbers.

### Orphelins

These are the 8 numbers between the Large and Small series. They can either be combined with 5 piece bets or played with 8 pieces en plein.

### Zero game

Including the 0 (zero), a 4-piece bet is placed to combine 7 numbers.

### Playing with neighbors

In this version, the bet is placed on a number and the 1, 2, 3 or 4 neighbors to its left and right - for instance, on the 9 and its two neighbors to the left and right 14, 31, 22 and 18.

## Announces without a Corresponding Field on the Table

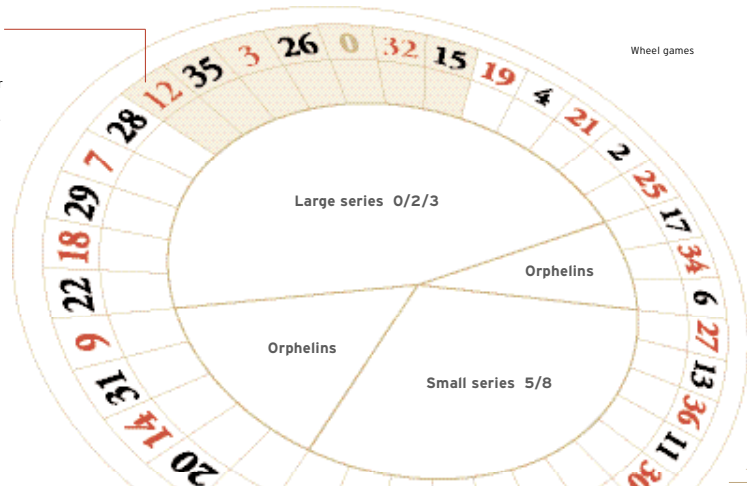
There are international standard announces (call bets) with no special fields on the table. If you want to play these announces, the croupier will place your bet for you.

### Game 7/9

A bet is placed on 9 numbers: 19 and 27 en plein as well as 7/8, 8/9, 17/18 and 28/29 à cheval.

### Final Bets

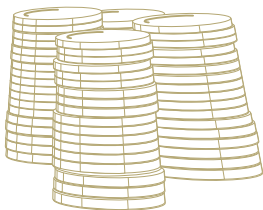
Finals are rows of numbers that end in the same number. For example: final 1 = 1, 11, 21, 31 or final 7 = 7, 17, 27. These final numbers can either be placed individually (en plein) or in combination (à cheval). When played à cheval, only those combinations of numbers which are located directly next to one another on the table are possible. An example: final 8/11 = 8/11, 18/21, 28/31.



## Bets and Payouts

The bets used at roulette tables vary. The following table will provide you with a brief overview of the minimum and maximum bets you can place. The information in the betting hall or at the individual tables is authoritative, however.

## American Roulette

American Roulette is played to the same rules as French Roulette. A croupier watches over the game and guests place their own bets. The game then moves more quickly. The playing field is also slightly different. The croupier identifies the winning number with a small figure on the tableau. The winning plan is also the same as in French Roulette, but with one exception: if zero wins, even bets are always halved.

### Playing the game

"Place your bets, please" – the croupier instructs players to place their special chips, either on individual numbers or combinations of numbers. "No more bets, please!" means that no more chips are to be placed. The number that the ball is on when it has stopped moving is the winning number. The croupier now places a small figure on the corresponding field on the tableau to indicate the winning number.

### Special rule for zero

The game differs in French Roulette when 0 (zero) wins. There betting can be "blocked" when the odds are even, but in this version the winnings are halved; one half then goes back to the player, or may be placed again.

### Special chips

American Roulette is placed with "special chips" that can be bought at the table. They are available in different colors and do not have a specific value. The guest determines the value when buying. The guest must cash in his special chips when he leaves the table; they cannot be used at other tables. However, the chips used in the French version may also be used in American Roulette.

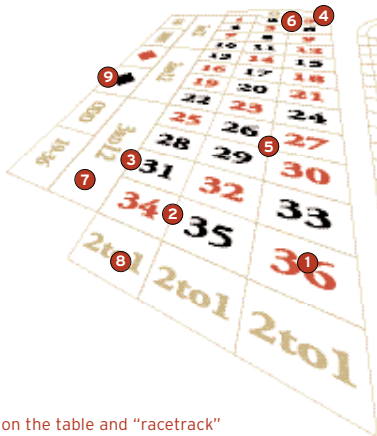
### The line-up of neighbors

One peculiarity of American Roulette is the "racetrack" – the betting area for neighbors. The oval playing field is next to the table. Bets can be placed on "neighbors". The numbers are in exactly the same order as on the Roulette wheel.

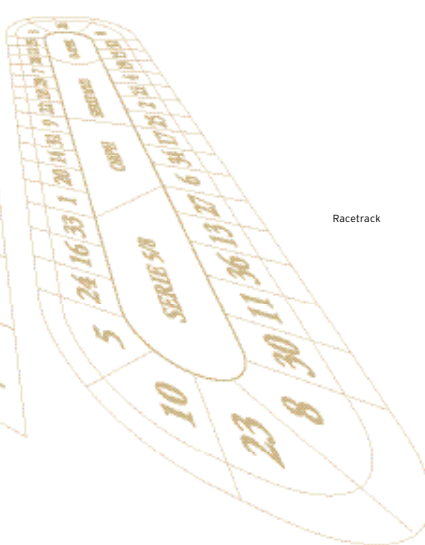
Announces such as Small series, Large Series, Orphelins and the zero game can be played on the "racetrack". Other announces are not normally accepted to avoid slowing the game down.

## Betting and winning on the table and "racetrack"

## Betting on the wheel

As in French Roulette, the numbers on the wheel enable bets to be placed on different number combinations.

### Series 0/2/3

Bet on a combination of 17 neighbors.

### Series 5/8

Bet on a combination of 12 neighbors.

### Orphelins

These are the 8 numbers between the Big and Small series. They may either be combined with 5 bets or played en plein with 8.

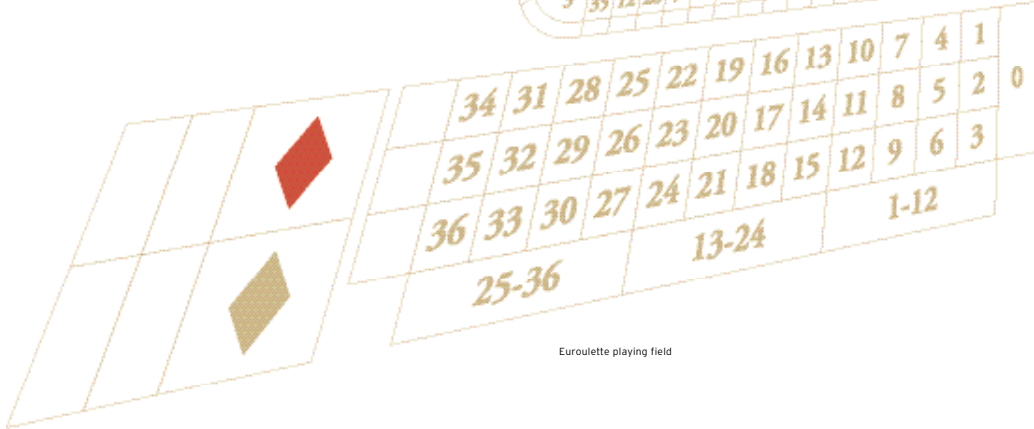
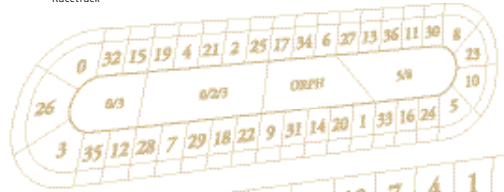
### Zero game

Including the 0 (zero), 4 bets are played combining 7 numbers.

### Playing neighbors

The bet is placed on a number and the 1, 2, 3 or 4 neighbors to its left or right - for instance, on 9 and then on 14, 31, 22 and 18.

## Eurolette

Not just a different table: Eurolette is only available in Baden-Württemberg – the first innovation in Roulette for over 250 years.

### Bar form

The table and wheel are in different places. This means that you as the punter are in direct contact with the croupier, and can easily place your bets on the table. This means that there is virtually no chance of misunderstanding. There's also somewhere for you to keep your drink and an ashtray to complete the bar feeling.

### Betting

French Roulette is played with chips. In contrast to French and American Roulette, the evens in Eurolette are limited to red and black, dozens and columns. Betting and winning are the same as in the French version (see page 5).
